Our mission is to collect and provide clothing and other necessities to the homeless and working poor of Northeastern New Jersey and to raise awareness of the plight of the homeless and working poor in this area and beyond.


Heart 'n Hands Mission of St. Timothy Lutheran Church is an Outreach Ministry which provides quality donated clothing and personal care items to the homeless and working poor at five food pantries, soup kitchens and community outreach programs in Paterson, Passaic and Hoboken. We also assist the homeless in Newark, the Broad Street Benches program in Elizabeth, the Light Up Project in Palisades Park, GERA – a refugee assistance program in Paterson, and provide clothing for Veterans and their families through Catholic Charities in Paterson, Passaic and Clifton. We are in our thirteenth year of service in Wayne, reaching more than **4,000** people with our monthly distributions. In addition, we support Wayne Interfaith Network and members of the Wayne community. Heart 'n Hands Mission is 100% volunteer and 100% of all monetary donations go directly to meet the needs of the homeless and working poor.

#### Our New Monthly Collection Program

In January, we began our monthly collection program with a request for warm gloves and in February we collected adult crew socks. We sincerely thank all who donated warm gloves and socks to the Mission. Our homeless friends were thrilled and comforted on those cold winter days and nights. In March, we received 10 travel shaving creams. In April we will be asking for donations of toothbrushes and full-size toothpaste. Please keep our monthly collections in mind when you are shopping. Every donation makes a difference to those who are struggling.

April – toothbrushes or full-size toothpaste May – travel or full-size deodorant June – travel size sun screen July – travel or full-size shampoo August – dental floss or flossers September – travel size lotion October – travel size body wash or boxed soap November – protein bars December – travel size talc free powder

In November of last year, we were contacted by **Rose Pagan** of **A Hero's Welcome-NNJ** about a coat drive she was organizing and asked if the Mission needed coats. Rose was working with members of the **Hasbrouck Heights Green Team** and the **Hasbrouck Heights Contemporary Club** to organize the drive on January 12<sup>th</sup>. Bob and Cathe Davidson picked up the massive donation which included 156 coats, 23 fleeces and sweatshirts, feminine hygiene products, scarves and hats, travel size toiletries, and more than 200 pairs of socks! In March, they held another clothing drive for business attire and donated 1,000 articles of clothing including men's and women's suits, blazers, slacks, shirts, blouses, skirts, dresses, and over 100 pairs of dress shoes.

We are so grateful to Rose and the members of the HH Green Team and the HH Contemporary Club for organizing these drives and bagging the items by gender, size and type. What a tremendous effort to help the Mission expedite deliveries to those in need.

#### Montville Partners Help Each Other

Two organizations in Montville collect donated clothing to help those in need. When each were overwhelmed with generous donations and few volunteers to help sort and distribute, they called on Heart 'n Hands Mission for support. We were happy to pick up 3 van loads of donations from **The Upper Room** and **The Hazel Project** to distribute to our friends in need throughout Northeastern New Jersey. We sincerely thank **Darlene Irwin, Renee** and **Ron Gilbert** from The Upper Room and **Rachel** from The Hazel Project, as well as **Roberta Ginsberg** for reaching out to us. There are so many individuals and families in need in New Jersey, it was our pleasure to assist these wonderful organizations in service as they take time to restructure their programs.

#### Pines Lake Women's Club

We want to thank the **Pines Lake Women's Club** for their generous donations of clothing that just seemed to keep on coming! Special thanks to the members who delivered all of the bags on Monday mornings. We also found a special bag containing 50 bags of blessings from an anonymous donor. Each bag contained an emergency blanket, a raincoat, a pack of tissues, Band-aids, a small pack of cookies and hand wipes. These gifts were truly a blessing to those in need and we thank everyone who donated through the Pines Lake Women's Club for their kindness.

#### Grace's Closet Helps Teens

**Grace's Closet** is an outreach program at **Grace Episcopal Church** of Rutherford. This year they held their second annual Give Grace Boutique and collected more than 1,000 prom dresses, shoes, jewelry and accessories to help area high school teens feel beautiful for their proms and other special events. The volunteers at Heart 'n Hands Mission are grateful to our supporters who donated special occasion dresses, fancy shoes and handbags, and we are happy to lend our support to Grace's Closet. We hope these teens feel the love as they prepare for their proms!



#### St. Timothy Sponsors a Refugee Family

#### Care Kit Program

Heart 'n Hands Mission is focused on providing much-needed Care Kits on a regular basis throughout the year to our sites that provide services to the homeless. Our goal is to assemble a minimum of 250 Care Kits for distribution every month. Each Care Kit fits in either a sandwich or quart size food storage bag. Our homeless friends depend on these donations to help them maintain good health and hygiene.

Each Care Kit contains 1-to-2-ounce travel size items. See examples below:



We also assemble Care Kits of feminine hygiene products. These kits include a variety of pads, liners, tampons and feminine wipes. Our homeless women are so grateful for these monthly essentials.



#### Let Us Introduce our Partner Organizations

We would like to introduce you to our partner organizations that benefit from your continuing support of Heart 'n Hands Mission. Our first is **Community Outreach Services, Inc.** in Paterson.

Community Outreach Services, Inc., began in 2006 when Rev. Wayne Brown took a phone call from a woman who wished to donate a box of food to the hungry. Rev. Brown soon realized the extent of hunger and homelessness in the community and accepted the challenge to establish a food ministry. Over the next several months, Rev. Brown and his wife Elisa brought food to hundreds of families in the community.



In 2010 Rev. Brown formally established Community Outreach Services, Inc. as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit and moved it into the facility on 6th Avenue in Paterson, NJ. Today, thanks to donors and volunteers like you, Community Outreach Services serves over 1,200 families per month, providing nutritious food, warm clothing, job assistance and referral assistance for help with utilities, rent and household furniture.

We were saddened to learn of the sudden death of Rev. Brown in February. He was a warm and caring man and always expressed heartfelt thanks for all that we provided to his outreach ministry. His wife, children, and supporters are continuing his legacy of assistance and we will continue to support them. Please join us in offering prayers for his family. May God grant him eternal rest.
